



At Care and Share we have been busy with updates to both of our buildings, all made possible by renovation grants from the State of Minnesota. Some of the more visible outside improvements are new roofs on both buildings, and the start of the elevator installation at the main Care and Share building. Some not so visible, but very important updates include a new boiler system for the Hope Center building and a significant upgrade of the boiler system in the main Care and Share building. We are also in the process of getting new windows for the Hope Center building. We are pleased with our progress towards better accessibility and energy efficiency for our older buildings. This is what the grants were designed to address, and we are well on our way to meeting our renovation goals.

Board member introductions


